Immigrant victims of crime in the US may be fearful to report crimes or seek help because of their immigration status. However, US law provides immigrant victims of crime several protections. Victims of violent crimes, like domestic violence or human trafficking, may qualify for U or T visas. This panel will present information about how agencies certify these requests.
